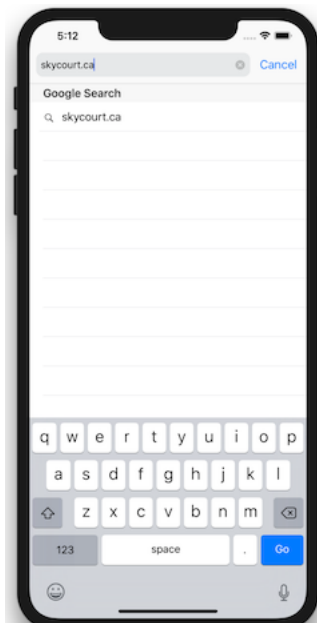


## How to add SkyCourt to your phone's desktop as an icon

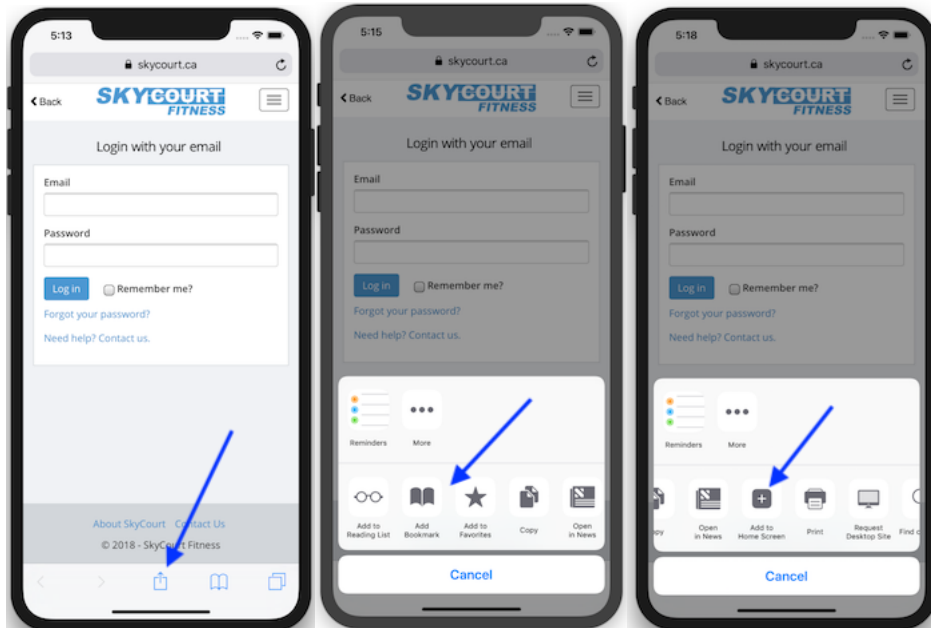
This document will explain how to put SkyCourt on the desktop of your phone, whether your phone is an android device or an iOS device. SkyCourt is not a native app, but it is a web app. Follow these instructions and the end result will be an app on your desktop that behaves just like a native phone app.

### iOS

Launch Safari and go to the website SkyCourt.ca.



You don't have to login yet. Instead press on the square with the upward pointing arrow:



After clicking on the box with the upward arrow, you will see the second image above. Scroll the row of icons to the left so that you can see the Add to Home Screen icon. Click on that icon to save the SkyCourt app to your desktop.

This screen comes up giving you a chance to name the SkyCourt app whatever you want. For instance, you can name it the name of your club. Tap “Done” when you are happy with the name you are giving it.



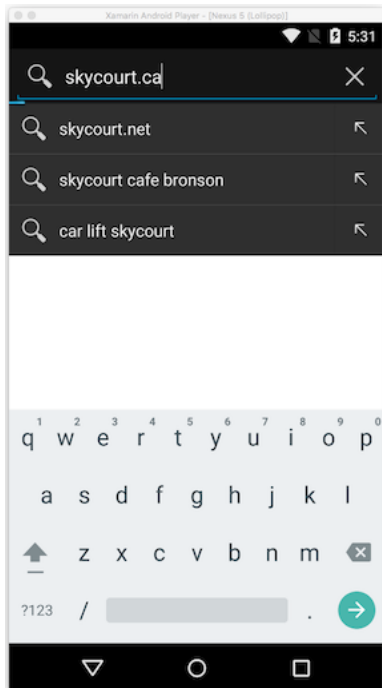
At this point, SkyCourt has been added to the desktop of your phone and can be launched with a single click. The first time that you click on it, you will be asked to login. Be sure to click the

“Remember me?” check box so that you don’t have to enter your password every time you launch SkyCourt.

## Android

This guide assumes that you will be using the Chrome browser that comes with your Android device. Some manufacturers provide their own version of the Chrome browser that may have the menu options in a different location or the look of the menu options may be different. If you can launch chrome on your device, that would be the best option for following this guide.

Launch Chrome and go to the site [skycourt.ca](http://skycourt.ca).



Then click on the icon in the upper right that is the three vertical dots. This brings up a menu of choices. Select the “Add to Home screen” option. Give the icon a name of your choosing – maybe the name of your club and select Add.

You now get a SkyCourt icon on your home screen that launches the site directly. When you first log into SkyCourt select the “Remember me?” check box so that you clicking on the icon behaves more like an App and you aren’t prompted for your password each time.
